Respected Comrade Kim Jong Un Guides Construction of Sinuiju Combined Greenhouse Farm Again



Kim Jong Un, general secretary of the Workers' Party of Korea and president of the State Affairs of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, guided again on the spot the construction of the Sinuiju Combined Greenhouse Farm in its final stage on October 17.

The respected Comrade Kim Jong Un was accompanied by Jo Yong Won, Pak Jong Chon, Kim Tok Hun, No Kwang Chol, Kim Jae Ryong, Kim Yong Su and other leading officials.

He was greeted on the spot by commanding officers of the units of the Korean People's Army and officials of the Paektusan Hero Youth Shock Brigade and design and relevant institutions, which are involved in the construction project.

True to the on-site instructions given by Kim Jong Un on September 18, the KPA units and members of the youth shock brigade were pushing ahead with the last stage after mainly completing the construction project covering a vast area.

At present, nearly 90 percent of the total workload of the project has been carried out.

Kim Jong Un went round the section of edaphic glasshouses, the vegetable science research centre, Soho Branch Farm and other places of the construction site to learn in detail about the equipment assembly and site clearing.

He said that construction of the Sinuiju Combined Greenhouse Farm is another gigantic creative undertaking for promoting the independent and diversified development of the regional economy and proving the validity and vitality of the Party's policy on regional development in the new era and, therefore, it is necessary to open up a new path of rural civilization not only in architecture but also in environmental arrangement and landscaping.

Placing a particular emphasis on the task of creating a distinctive landscape by making effective use of the natural environment while preserving the characteristics of the island area, he gave instructions on directing all efforts and means to dynamically pushing ahead with





site clearing, landscaping and creation of windbreak forest in the vast area of the greenhouse farm.

He pointed out some deviations revealed in designing and paving roads in the area of the farm.

He set forth a series of important tasks arising in the last stage of construction, the operation of the farm and the conservation and administration of land and river, including those of making good preparations for the management of the farm, mobilizing machinery in a concentrated way to qualitatively complete the environmental

arrangement of the surroundings of the construction site and taking measures for raising the level of specialization in environmental protection and management.

He expressed belief that all the soldier-builders and members of the youth shock brigade would perfectly complete the large-scale greenhouse farm without fail by redoubling their efforts and displaying dauntless courage, always bearing in mind the trust and expectation of the Party and the people, and thus present it to the glorious Party congress.



Respected Comrade Kim Jong Un Visits Kangdong County Hospital Nearing Completion



Kim Jong Un, general secretary of the Workers' Party of Korea and president of the State Affairs of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, visited the Kangdong County Hospital, which is nearing completion, on October 30.

He was accompanied by Jo Yong Won, secretary of the Central Committee of the WPK.

Going round various places of the hospital including the underground parking lot, inpatient ward, operating theatre and doctors' room, he learned in detail about the construction.

As he instructed officials to assemble and install in a responsible manner the medical equipment within November as the overall construction of the hospital has been completed at a highly qualitative level, he set forth various tasks for the preparations for operating the

hospital.

He underlined the need to promptly disseminate the excellent experience gained in the construction of the hospital and exemplary creative spirit displayed in it to the regional construction units at all levels in order to implement the project of public health modernization across the country on a full scale and at the highest qualitative level.

As the construction of hospital, an ensemble of the latest medical technology and architectural techniques, requires a higher level of functionality and specialization than any other construction projects, it presents itself as a primary task to build up the regional construction forces capable of carrying out the huge projects for public health development in order to accelerate their implementation on a



scientific basis and in a far-sighted way, he said.

Protecting the lives and safety of all citizens and promoting their health is one of the most important state affairs and, therefore, the WPK's policy on the public health revolution should be steadily expanded and intensified, he stressed.

Our important goal in modernizing the public health sector from now on is to build without fail such modern hospitals as the Kangdong County Hospital in 20 cities and counties every year, he said, adding that a decisive measure should be adopted to expand the country's forces for building public health facilities.

He continued that the forthcoming plenary meeting of the Party Central Committee will examine the issue of building such modern hospitals in the districts of Pyongyang Municipality.

Also present there were Aleksandr Matsegora, Russian




ambassador to the DPRK, and the Russian embassy staff.

The festival served as a significant occasion in deepening the good-neighbourly relations among the world progressive countries and the friendly ties among film artistes under the ideals of independence, peace and friendship.



Sportspeople Bring Honour to Their Motherland

The DPRK won 74 medals, including 46 golds, and a trophy and came first in the country rankings at the 23rd ITF Taekwon-Do World Championships.

The championships brought together over 1 180 contenders from more than 70 countries and regions including the DPRK, Mongolia, Kazakhstan, Greece, Canada and Argentina.

The DPRK took the first place in the men's and women's team pattern competitions in the senior, youth and juvenile categories, women's team sparring competition in the senior category, men's team sparring competition in the youth category, men's and women's self-defence competitions in the senior, youth and juvenile categories, and women's team power demonstration competition in the senior category.

The DPRK topped the country and regional medal tallies at the 2025 IWF World Championships.

The championships, held in Norway, drew more than 470 weightlifters from over 80 countries and regions including the DPRK, China, Bulgaria, Canada and Egypt.

The DPRK's weightlifters won 23 medals in total—17 golds, five silvers and a bronze—and set ten new world records.





Gold Medallists at the 2025 World Wrestling Championships

Won Myong Gyong from the Jangsan Sports Team

Won Myong Gyong took the first place in the women's 50kg category at the 2025 World Wrestling Championships.

Back in 2016, she won gold in the 40kg category at the Asian youth wrestling championships.

She is the first world champion produced by the Jangsan Sports Team.



O Kyong Ryong from the Pyongyang Sports Club

O Kyong Ryong won gold in the women's 55kg category at the 2025 Asian Wrestling Championships; her match with a Japanese rival, who was a two-time world champion, was quite impressive.

She also came first in the 55kg category at the 2025 World Wrestling Championships.



Han Chong Song from the April 25 Combat Sports Team

Han Chong Song won gold at the 2025 Asian Wrestling Championships and the 2025 World Wrestling Championships this year.

At the latter championships the contenders in his category totaled 30 or so, many of whom had won gold at continental championships or distinguished themselves at the 33rd Olympic Games.

Ri Song Ho was awarded the AFC Coach of the Year (Men) at the AFC Awards Riyadh 2025.

He is the third winner of this award in the DPRK.

Choe Il Son was awarded the AFC Youth Player of the Year (Women) at the AFC Awards Riyadh 2025.

She proved herself to be outstanding in physical, technical and scoring abilities at the 2024 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup.

She is the fourth winner of this award in the DPRK.



Gold Medal and New Record at the Third Asian Youth Games


Kang Ryon Hui

Transformed Mountainous Region

Visit to Unsan County, North Phyongan Province

Unsan County is located in an eastern part of North Phyongan Province.

It is characteristic with many mountains, rivers and streams and frequent rain. Because of these natural and geographical features, it was prone to disasters by rain.

Now it has undergone a sea change. Hundreds of houses were built at state

expense, and recently administration and production buildings, hall of culture, clinic, ten-day kindergarten and nursery have sprung up in Tapsang-ri, preserving the characteristics of the rural community.

The new regional-industry factories, which belong to the first entities of the Workers' Party of Korea's policy of

regional rejuvenation, produce goods including soybean paste and sauce, various drinks, pine nut biscuits, plastic goods of diversified shapes and with beautiful patterns and mugwort-flavoured soaps.

It is a source of pride for the local people that all products of their foodstuff factory are made with the raw materials available





in their county.

The county has effectively conducted forest and water conservation, increasing the area of forests of trees of economic value

and building embankments along the rivers and streams. In the course of this, new crop fields have been obtained, and those that suffered damage from cold weather have

been improved, yielding bumper crops.

The locals are striving to further transform their land.

The Hwasong Kumgang House is located in a newly-built urban section of the Hwasong area in Pyongyang.


Not so long after its inauguration, the house already ranks among the popular commercial outlets in the capital city.

In the centre equipped with up-to-date


computers and other equipment, they play popular video games.

PAGYON FALLS

Pagyon Falls, one of the three major waterfalls of Korea, is in Pagyon-ri in Kaesong.

There is a singular pond, called Pagyon, originally a broad and flat rock which was dug in the shape of a gourd.

The speed of water falling down is faster than that of other waterfalls, and the falling water produces a rumbling sound.

The misty fog formed by the falling water adds more to the landscape.





Under the waterfall is Komo Pond, 120m in circumference and 40m in diameter. On one side of the pond is a round rock, called Ryong, whose most part is submerged in water.


The steep cliff on the southern side and craggy precipices soaring high around add much to the beauty of the waterfall.

In the resort there are historical remains including Kwanum Temple and Taehungsan Fort.

Mausoleum of King Tongmyong

The Mausoleum of King Tongmyong, the founder king of Koguryo, is a valuable historical relic; as the first feudal state in the history of the Korean nation, Koguryo was noted for its great strength.

The mausoleum was inscribed on the world heritage list in 2004.

The Mausoleum of King Tongmyong, the founder king of Koguryo (277 BC-AD 668) which was the first feudal state in the history of the Korean nation, is situated in Ryokpho District, Pyongyang.

It was renovated in May 1993 under the wise leadership of President Kim Il Sung and Chairman Kim Jong Il.

There is a pine forest of nearly 40 hectares on the hill around it. The forest, hundreds of years old, was created particularly for

the mausoleum.

The pine trees add more to the picturesque scenery of the mausoleum.

The Mausoleum of King Tongmyong district, including the pine forest, covers 170 hectares.

The mausoleum, a stone-chambered earth tomb, faces the south. The lower part of the mausoleum, which is 11.5m high, is a square-shaped plinth of stones, each side of which is 34m long.





The interior of the tomb is composed of inner chamber, front compartment and grave passage, and lotus flowers are painted on the walls and ceiling of the inner chamber.

In front of the tomb are a stone altar and stone lantern and on both sides of the tomb are stone posts, stone tigers and stone incense burners. Stone statues of civilian and military officers, who contributed to the founding and development of Koguryo, stand on both sides.

The Jongnung Temple from the Koguryo period, unearthed in the course of discovering the relics around the mausoleum, is situated 120m south of the mausoleum.

The mausoleum was inscribed on the world heritage list in 2004.

Associated with the long history and culture of the nation, it is under protection.
